Farr 30 International Regatta 2016

Notice of Race

Date: August 1 - 6, 2016

Place: Båstad, Sweden (56°26'0"N, 12°50'30"E)

Organizer: Båstad Boat and Yacht Club in cooperation with Sailing Båstad and Swedish Farr 30 Class Association

Note As the regatta has been approved by the Swedish Sailing Federation to be a Swedish Championship there is amendment to Notice of Race.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 No national prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3 Swedish competitors shall when racing follow the licensing rules for advertising as decided by the Swedish Sailing Federation.
- 1.4 Farr 30 International Class Rules will apply.
- 1.5 Competitors shall when afloat wear personal flotation devices. This rule does not apply to short-term replacement or adjustment of clothing or personal equipment, or when competitors are in the harbour or under deck. Wet suits and dry suits are not personal flotation devices. This changes RRS 40. A boat that breaks this rule may be warned or penalized at the discretion of the protest committee. (DPI)
- 1.6 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.
- 1.7 Video and/or photographs taken from any source shall not be used as evidence at protest hearings. This changes RRS 63.6.

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all Farr 30 Class yachts as defined by the Class Rules.
- 3.2 The person in charge on board the boat shall be a member of his/her Member National Authority or one of its affiliated organisations.
- 3.3 The person in charge on board shall follow Swedish Sailing Federations license rules for competitors. This rule applies from the year competitors reach the age of 13. Competitors from other countries than Sweden are exempt from this rule.

- 3.4 Entry registration shall be made not later than 2015-07-11 to Sailing Båstad. The entry registration is not valid until the Organizer receives the entry fee.
After 2015-07-11 entry registration can be done for an additional fee.
- 3.5 The entry registration shall be done online at www.seglarveckanbastad.se and include the information requested in the form.

4 FEES

- 4.1 Required fees are as follows:

The entry fee is 10000 SEK.

For entries or payments after 2015-07-11 the entry fee is 12000 SEK.

The entry fee is not refundable.

6 MEASUREMENTS

- 6.1 Registrations shall be made at the Race Office not later than 2016-08-02 18.00

- 6.2 Measurement certificates shall be presented prior to racing.

6.3 All boats must be checked prior to the regatta. The measurement plan will be available at registration.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be handed out at registration.

8 VENUE

8.1 The racing area will be in the Laholm Bay outside Båstad harbour. A map of the sailing area is available on www.seglarveckanbastad.se

9 THE COURSES

A Windward-leeward course will be sailed and will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

10.1 The penalties are as follows: Appendix P shall apply. Rule P2.3 will not apply and rule P2.2 is changed so that it will apply to any penalty after the first one.

11 SCORING

11.1 (a) When fewer than four (4) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When four (4) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

12 SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall be marked with flag provided by the race committee.

13 BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in the harbour.

14 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

Keelboats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.

15 DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS

Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around keelboats between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the regatta.

16 RADIO COMMUNICATION

16.1 Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

- 16.2 Race information will be given on marine VHF (156-162MHz). The Channel will be stated in the SIs. The Organizer reminds participants that the use of VHF is governed by the applicable laws. It is the owner's/helmsman's responsibility to fulfil all legal requirements to carry with and use marine VHF radio on board a yacht.

17 PRIZES

- 17.1 First to third places will be awarded with prizes.

18 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Risk Statement

Rule 4 of the Racing Rules of Sailing states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone". Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:

- 18.1 They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event.
- 18.2 They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore.
- 18.3 They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions.
- 18.4 Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate.
- 18.5 The provision of a race management team, patrol boats and other officials and volunteers by the organizer does not relieve them of their own responsibilities.
- 18.6 The provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances.

19 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of EUR 1 000 000 per incident or the equivalent.
